**CHARLES E. PRICE MEMORIAL PARK AT LEVELS ROAD**  
**GENERAL PARK RULES and REGULATIONS**

1. A permit is issued for all reservations and must be shown upon request.
2. **All vehicles must park in designated parking areas.** (Fire lanes and handicapped parking must be obeyed.) **No vehicles or equipment (including entertainment type) are allowed to park in the grassed areas.**
3. Vehicles must stay off walking paths.
4. Walking paths are not to be blocked at any time.
5. All pets must be on a leash when not in designated area. All droppings must be removed.
6. Beer or alcoholic beverages are not permitted on park premises.
7. Absolutely no motor vehicles are permitted in any area of the park except on the paved parking areas provided.
8. Persons or teams using Town facilities without reservations must surrender same at once to anyone presenting an official permit.
9. The pond is “catch and release” only. A State of Delaware fishing license is required for anyone over the age of 16. Fishing licenses are not required for anyone over the age of 65.
10. No stakes are to be driven into the ground – no tents or inflatables are allowed.
11. No live bait and no barbed hooks are allowed.
12. No boats are allowed in the fishing pond.
13. No pull-behind cookers, etc. are allowed.
14. No animal acts, fireworks, rocket launchers, dunk tanks, etc., are permitted in the park.
15. The loading and unloading area is strictly for that purpose only – no permanent parking is allowed in this area.
16. Permittee agrees to clear area of all trash before leaving and place all trash in containers provided for such purposes. Please bring additional trash bags for garbage.
17. All posted regulations must be adhered to.

18. By acceptance of this permit, it is understood and agreed by the permittee that it shall be solely responsible for any damage to the premises caused by its use under this permit and that the Town of Middletown shall not be liable or responsible in any manner whatsoever for any damage to property or injury to persons upon the premises.
19. The permittee accepts the use of the premises in the condition as found and agrees to indemnify the Town of Middletown from any and all liability for injury to persons or property arising out of the use of the premises by those authorized by the permit or those not authorized by the permit but nevertheless using the premises with the consent of the permit holder. The permittee and its guests, members or patrons assumes the risk of injury to persons or property upon the premises by exercising this permit.
20. Permittee shall supply to the Town of Middletown a Certificate of Insurance indicating minimum General Liability limits of \$1,000,000, and naming the Town of Middletown as Additional Insured.
21. Failure to abide by any of the above rules may result in the offending person, persons, or group being barred from future use of the Middletown Park.
22. **The park closes at dusk. Pavilion rentals must be cleaned up by 6 p.m.**
